

Wuhan Virus Pandemic Created Heroes but also Lice Huang Lian

Incarcerated Zhang Zhan's Health Takes a Turn for the Worse

Heartbreaking news: Chinese lawyer, citizen reporter Zhang Zhan, because of her reportage of the Wuhan Virus pandemic, was sentenced of four years imprisonment; so far, she has already spent 1200 days of fasting in jail, with another 261 days before she serves out her sentence. Having just celebrated her 40th birthday in prison, her health has been gradually deteriorating, and her weight is now down to 37 kilos, half of what she weighed before her arrest. Recently she was transferred from Shanghai Women Prison to hospital for treatment. Some international organizations have called for the release of Zhang Zhan, lest her health would be further endangered.

We quote here a piece that Zhang Zhan wrote on March 25th, 2020, "I had thought that within this nation there would be some who could escape the web cast by the system, and not be crushed by one's fate or the ravages of time. There would be those fortunate ones, and I had so hoped to be one of them. But I just realized that this socialist system exerts a firm grip on the fate of everyone. No one is spared, it is only that some people manage to put on a happy face or a beautiful superficiality on the surface. Within the system, using Eileen Chang's analogy, we are all lice.

Using the power of her pen, Zhang Zhan sharply criticize and call out the Chinese Communist political system's utter destruction of the people's humanity, leading to her incarceration. Shi Zhengli's Earthshattering Revelations to Expose the Darkness

Shi Zhengli, researcher for the Chinese Academy of Sciences' Wuhan Institute of Virology, who was shortlisted for membership of the Chinese Academy of Sciences in 2023, a revelation that caused a major stir in the world. Going back to the early days of the pandemic, got caught in the center of the storm as "Batwoman", because of her work with SARS-like coronaviruses. In social media, she cared nothing of her status as an academic, and famously retorted to the many questions posed and suspicions raised, "Shut your stinking mouth", revealing her extremely arrogant attitude. Thereafter, she basically disappeared from public view, and refused any request for interviews from the media, as well as questions posed by colleagues.

It is worth mentioning that a document obtained by DRASTIC (Dedicated Research and Scientific Team Investigating COVID-19), a grassroots organization investigating the root causes of the Wuhan virus, made the earthshattering revelation previously hidden in the dark – how Shi Zhengli attempted to change this laboratory-manufactured virus into something that naturally

occurs. In the mysterious bat cave in China's Yunnan Province, Shi Zhengli and cohorts released SARS-CoV-2 virus, as well as skin-penetrating viral nanoparticle aerosol. The Familiar Face of this Terrible Man-made Contagion

Looking back in history back to 2012, when Shi Zhengli was collaborating with certain universities in the United States to investigate fighting SARS, receiving financial assistance from the United States Department of Defence. In her report, she proposed genetic modification of the virus, receiving an immediate warning from the Americans, stressing that this would be a dangerous endeavour which might lead to catastrophic consequences the world over. However, Shi Zhengli insisted, and the Department of Defence withdrew its subsidy in 2014. But Ralph S. Baric, professor at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, is a world authority on viruses, and had pioneered genetic modifications as well as gain of function technology. With such a significant figure as her backing, as well as receiving samples of the virus developed by Baric, she successfully researched four strains of the virus in 2017, "success" referring to its virulence as well as its efficacy in inflicting harm. There were two strains that cause particularly serious damage – one causes lung albinism and then loss of function and asphyxiation; the other inflicts damage to the immune system, causing it to "betray" the body and attack the host.

This frightful man-made virus has a familiar face, and the reason behind its development sends shudder through the body. Shi Zhengli took this ostensibly top-secret document and released it on Central China Television (CCTV) in 2018, revealing much of her research as well as detailing details of the genetic modifications. The rationale was of course to make boast in the face of the United States Department of Defence, but this also became ironclad evidence of the origins of the Wuhan virus.

Warning of the Chinese Communists Unrestricted Warfare

Criteria for membership in the Chinese Academy of Sciences is becoming more fanatical and political. Remember the case of the 2015 Nobel Prize for Medicine, Tu Youyou? She was nominated for membership to the Chinese Academy of Sciences numerous times, but was not elected. After receiving the Nobel Prize, there was much commentary and discussions about how China evaluates the "usefulness" of its scientists, but these discussions led nowhere, and she was never even nominated.

What warrants our particular attention was the appearance of the name of Shi Zhengli on the shortlist for the Chinese Academy of Sciences, a name that we hadn't heard much of; this became the focus of many news reports, and it shows that China no longer cares about questions on the origins of the Wuhan virus.

China's actions have two layers of meaning. Firstly, the United States Congress' "Assessment of the Origins of COVID-19" began with much fanfare but amounted to nothing, so far declassifying only a mere four pages, and if China continues to be not transparent and uncooperative, the origins of COVID-19 would remain a mystery. This would embolden Xi Jinping. Shi Zhengli is someone ridiculed by public opinion as one who contributed toward "a Chinese-flavoured international supply chain", and should have been someone who hide behind the scenes, someone who should not be seen by anyone; and now Xi Jinping is personally taking the lead to nominate her, giving her legitimacy and giving the Wuhan virus a public face.

Secondly, to give an internationally censured "scientist" membership in the Chinese Academy of Sciences shows that criteria for membership include fitting in with the nation's (that is, the Chinese Communists Party's) requirements, before earning the title of scientist. Xi Jinping is a man faced with many clear and present danger, especially the housecleaning within China's Rocket Force as well as the Strategic Support Force and the nuclear submarine mysterious "accident"; if he wants to surpass the United States in unrestricted warfare, Shi Zhengli's research on man-made virus would naturally play a crucial role – this is the need of Xi Jinping's nation.

To reiterate, is Shi Zhengli really among the "fortunate ones who put on a beautiful superficiality"?
